




Identity Documents Required for Smartcard Registration

In order to register for a Smartcard, please bring along 3 forms of ID to your appointment:



If you DO NOT have enough photos ID to satisfy the above, you can provide the following:



Each of the documents provided should be from different source and photograph must be endorsed on the back with a signature of a person of some standing in the community, such as: magistrate, medical practitioner, officer or the armed forces, teacher, lawyer, bank manager or civil servant who has known you for at least 3 years.

List of acceptable PHOTOGRAPHIC ID

- UK passport or EU/ other nationalities passport
- Passports of non-EU nationals and other valid evidence relating to their immigration status nad permission to work
- UK full or provisional photo-card driving licence (<u>must</u> include counterpart)
- EU/ other nationalities photo-card driving licence
- Biometric Residence Permit (formerly known as identity cards for foreign nationals)
- HM Armed Forces Identity card
- ID cards carrying the **PASS** accreditation logo i.e. UK Citizen ID card.

List of acceptable <u>proof</u> of address documents

- Utility bill (gas, water, electricity or landline telephone). Utility bills in joint names are also permissible. Electronic bills are acceptable providing you logon to the utility account in person.
- Local authority tax statement
- UK full or provisional driving licence (<u>must</u> include paper counterpart) it nor already presented as personal photographic identity.
- Most recent HMRC tax notification (i.e. tax assessment, statement of account, <u>NOT</u> P45 or P60)
- Financial statement such as bank, building society, or credit card statement
- Mortgage statement from a recognised lender
- Benefit statement, book or card' or original notification letter from the Department of Work and Pensions (DWP) confirming the rights to benefit i.e. child allowance, pension
- Confirmation from an electoral register search that a person of that name lives at the claimed adress
- Local council rent card or tenancy agreement

Acceptable <u>non-</u> photographic proof of ID

- Full birth certificate (UK and Channel Islands)
- Full birth certificate issued by UK authorities overseas i.e. embassies, high commissions and HM Forces
- UK full old-style paper driving licence
- Work permit/residency permit (UK)
- Adoption certificate (UK and Channel Islands)
- Marriage or civil partnership certificate (UK and Channel Islands)
- Divorce, dissolution or annulment papers (UK and Channel Islands)
- Gender recognition certificate
- Deed pool certificate
- Firearm certificate/licence (UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man)
- Police registration document
- Certificate of employment in the HM Forces (UK)
- Benefit statement, book or card' or original notification letter from the Department of Work and Pensions (DWP) confirming the rights to benefit i.e. child allowance, pension
- Most recent tax notification f

Acceptable documents for <u>16-</u> <u>19 year-olds</u> who have recently left full time education

- A grant or student loan agreement from a local education authority (UK)
- full birth certificate (UK and Channel Islands)
- National Insurance nuber of proof of issue of an NI number
- A letter from their headteacher or college principal can be requeted, verifying their name and other relevant information i.e. address or date of birth (UK)
- A document from a local/central government authority or local authority giving entitlement i.e. Employment Services, Job Centre, Social Security Services (UK and Channel Islands)
- A qualification certificate

Please ensure you bring along all of the relevant documentations to the appointment.

Without them we will not be able to carry out the registration.
