## **Releasing Timesheets**

Please ensure you authorise any historic bank shifts booked against the PAT using your old the PAT user log ins. You have until **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> April 2021** to authorise all historic bookings under the PAT after which your ability to do so will be removed – please ensure all timesheets are authorised by this date to prevent bank worker payment delays.

## **System Changes**

As previously advised, you are now unable to book retrospective shifts yourself, this is in line with MFT operating processes. Please refer to the local Trust policy for more information on the retrospective process for your service.
